

TUESDAY FOURSOMES

1. The Tuesday Foursomes bowling league shall consist of up to 12 teams and the league shall be sanctioned by the USBC. This league will bowl on Tuesdays at 6:00 p.m. with practice beginning at 5:50 p.m.
2. The Tuesday Foursomes will bowl for 34 weeks beginning August 15, 2017 and ending April 10, 2018. There will be no bowling on December 26th.
3. The season will be split in halves with a first half champion and a second half champion. Points awarded for wins will start over at the beginning of the second half. If there is a tie for first place based on points won at the end of either half, there will be a one game playoff to determine the champion. A ninth and tenth frame shall be bowled in the event of a tie at the end of the game. All other rules and conditions governing league play apply to the playoff. The last night of bowling will be the bowl-off between the two champions and all other teams will bowl a sweeper.
4. Weekly fees will be \$15.00 per member for a total of \$60.00 per team. The cost per line is \$12.00 for 3 games. Of the remaining \$3.00, we will bank \$2.75 for the prize fund and \$0.25 for secretarial fees. **Team captains are responsible for the team money.**
5. The secretary's salary shall be \$0.25 per person, per night, and shall be paid at the completion of the season.
6. This league will be a match point league with a total of 28 points – one for each individual game won and three for each team game won.
7. The board of directors shall consist of the league officers and team captains.

8. The handicap will be figured on an individual basis and will be 100% of the difference between an individual's average and 210.
9. Teams without a full roster shall use a vacancy score of 120 for men and 120 for women. Handicap will be based on that score.
10. The absentee score will be the absent bowler's average less 10 pins with handicap based on the actual average.
11. No late arriving members may start bowling after the last ball of the 4th frame has been bowled in any game.
12. At least 2 members from one team must be present and bowl or the game will be forfeited.
13. Forfeit win – a team must bowl within 40 pins under team average to win a game. A team bowling exactly 40 pins under their team average will win the point.
14. The league board of directors shall determine what is sufficient cause for a postponement. Requests for postponement, for reasons other than an emergency, must be made at least 24 hours prior to the next scheduled match. Team captains are to contact any officer when requesting a postponement.
15. All make-up games will be made up within 2 weeks of the originally scheduled bowling match. All make-ups must be completed prior to the final position round in each half. No individual make-ups will be allowed.
16. An individual or team shall be eligible for only one special prize for high game and high series. When a team or individual qualifies for a prize in each category, and prizes are of equal value, the series shall prevail. In all other cases, the prize of highest value will be awarded. This league will compete for cash only. The payout will be: \$20 per person for members of the 1st place team and \$25 each for handicap and scratch high game and high series for men and women.
17. Each team will provide their own subs.
18. Printouts must be turned in with all make-up games.
19. Each bowler will use last year's average in this league with 21 games or more or highest book average from last year for the first 9 games they bowl. If a person has no previous average, they must establish their average after the first 3 games bowled and go on from there.
20. There will be a position round the 17th week of bowling and the 33rd week.
21. All bowlers are to prepay the last night of bowling any time before April 3, 2018.
22. Any rules not covered above are governed by the USBC.
