

2022-2023 WC's League Rules (Women's Wednesday 4:50)

1. This league shall be known as the WC's League, which bowls on Wednesday at Sun Valley Lanes at 4:50 p.m. The league will consist of a minimum of 2 women on a team
2. The sanction fee for bowling this year is a flat \$27.00 dollar rate.
3. The cost of bowling, per member, is as follows:  
13.00 bowling expense  
1.70 prize fund  
.30 secretary/treasurer fee  
\$15.00 total per member per night  
It is the captain's responsibility that there is \$30.00 in their envelopes every week
4. Handicap shall be 85% of the difference of actual team averages. Game to be figured on handicap basis
5. Each bowler shall use last year's average in the league for 3 weeks. If a bowler did not bowl in this league last year, she shall use her highest book average of 21 games or more. If no book average is available, the bowler will establish an average the first night she bowls. This average will change with each series bowled each week.
6. Subs shall use the highest book average of 21 games or more for 3 weeks. If a bowler has no book average, she shall establish an average the first night she bowls. This average will change with each week. A summer average of 21 games or more is also acceptable for both rules #5 and #6 if no acceptable regular season average is available.
7. Blind score shall be absent bowler's average less 10 pins for game score. Handicap to be figured on absent bowler's actual average.
8. If a blind bowler must be used, and a team has more than 2 members, the scheduled bowlers average will be used. If a sub is obtained for a member, that member's average may not be used.
9. Vacancy rule....At the beginning of a season, if a team is short a member or if a member drops during the season, a vacancy score of 120 shall be used until a new member is

found. The league remains responsible for the vacancy score bowling expense unless this happens during the first 3 weeks of bowling.

10. Should a member appear after the match game has started, she may bowl providing that 5 frames of that game have not been completed. The tardy bowler must be on line and ready to bowl before the end of the 5th frame.
11. One regular member consists of a legal lineup.
12. If it is necessary to postpone games, notify the secretary. Kathy's phone number is 402-540-0275. If rescheduling of games is not possible the teams may bowl unopposed. The team that does not bowl on the regular night, during regular league bowling will be eligible for USBC or league awards. A league office or appointed representative who is not a bowling member or someone from the bowling center must be present. One or two members on a team may PRE-bowl if necessary but to POST-bowl, it has to be ALL team members at the same time. (It is preferred by the league that if you need to make up a night of bowling that it is done within 2 weeks of the night missed.)
13. This league shall bowl for 30 weeks. The last week being a 9-pin no tap or other "fun-night" activity and the scores of the fun week do not count in the standings and are not eligible for USBC or league awards. The handicap for the fun night will be figured at 80% from 200. The cost for fun night is \$15.00 per person, whether you bowl or not. \$13.00 to SV for lane expenses and \$1.70 to a fun night prize fund. All team members and subs can bowl the fun night
14. Position nights will be after each team has bowled one another the first time and again the second time. The last night of point bowling will be a position round (April 5, 2023)
15. Total pin count shall count as game won - 4 game system.
16. The missing team member is responsible for their sub's bowling money and the captain is to verify that the correct amount is in the envelope.
17. If a tie occurs between first and second place on the last night of bowling, there will be no roll-off. Whoever has the most total pins will be deemed the winner.
18. These rules shall be adopted by the league. Any other rules shall be governed by the USBC rule book.
19. Teams bowling unopposed due to team dropout or forfeit (no show), must bowl at least their team average less 30 pins per game and 90 pins for series for game won.

20. If participants in a team line-up are not current in league fees, the team need not forfeit but the person or persons who are in arrears do not bowl.
21. The vice-president is responsible for the bowling banquet and can form a committee however she desires. The committee is responsible for selecting the place for the banquet and it will be at regular bowling time, with no revote.
22. A bowler must bowl one third of the session to qualify for any USBC awards. Individual high game, individual high series, individual high hdcp game, and individual high hdcp series each pay \$10.00.
23. 18 year olds can sub and they would need to be sanctioned but if they participate it would forfeit their eligibility for high school athletics.
24. Please be courteous to all bowlers and be up to bowl when your name appears- so as to ensure that we are done on time.
